Introduction to Economic Indicator Service (EIS)

The Economic Indicator Service (EIS) aims to deliver professional economic content to financial institutions on both the buy and sell side service providers. This new service currently covers 44,351 recurring macro-economic indicators from 135 countries (as of December 16, 2019) such as GDP data, unemployment releases, PMI numbers etc.

EIS gathers the major economic events from a variety of regions and countries around the globe and provides an (1) Economic Events Data feed and Economic Calendar service to our clients. This service also includes all (2) previous historic data on economic indicators that are currently available on EIS's database.

Depending on availability, information regarding economic indicators, including the details of the issuing agency as well as historical data series can be made accessible for the client.

Key information about EIS:


- The Economic Calendar is a cloud-based service delivered via HTML/JavaScript application formats, which can then be embedded onto any website using iFrames.
- There are also alternatives methods available such as API and JSON feed for the economic calendar that can be integrated into the company's system
- Live data updated 24/5, immediately after the data has been released


The calendar includes the following:

- Indicators can be filtered across 16 subtypes.

- Indicator description and historical data up to the latest 8 historical points with a chart.

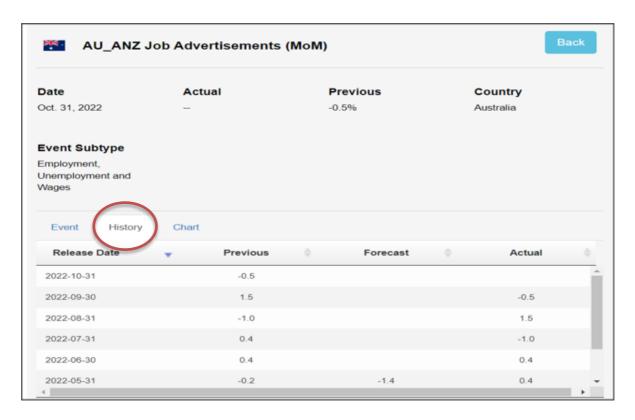


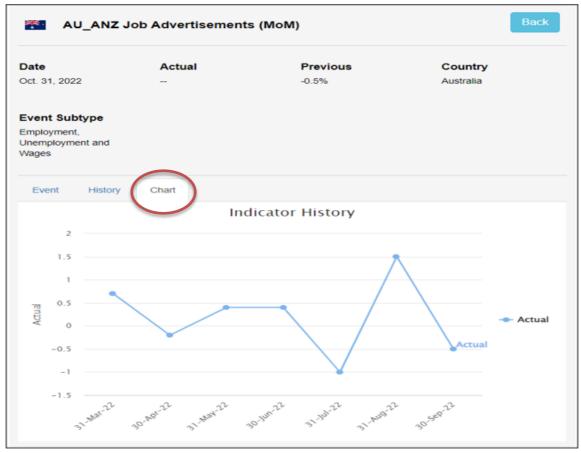

Delivery Method of the Economic Indicator Service

The two components available for the Economic Indicator Service are the following:

- Live Calendar updated 24/5 immediately after the data is released and with limited history for recurring indicators.
- Live Calendar can be embedded on client's website using iFrame or API.
- Historical database Database of all recurring indicators (with complete history) and non-recurring indicators. Historical Database can be made available via API or SFTP.

- Feed to client's website with customized branding
- Automatic feed to social media accounts, such as: Twitter and Facebook
