Date & Time

- When the data or event is released.
- Time of the data or event release. The Time Zone can be manipulated.

Country/Region

- Shows which economy is affected (e.g. US, Eurozone, South Africa, China).
- Important because some economies have more global impact than others.

Topic

Maps the event into a specific Topic. (Search can be done according to a specific Topic)

Indicator / Event Name

Short description like:

- “Consumer Confidence”
- “Inflation Rate (CPI)”
- “Unemployment Rate”
- “GDP Growth”

Effective Date

The period/date of the value.

Unit

Measurement of the numerical value.

Base

The specific starting point in time used to compare index data over time.

Previous, and Actual

- **Previous:** Last published value.
- **Actual:** The latest number that is released.

Search Form and Download

- The Form allows you to search according to month, year or use custom dates.
- Historical events are available from 2024 and provide event dates and times up to 5 years in advance.
- Any country(s) can be selected.
- Any topic can be selected.
- Selections can be downloaded into txt or csv format.
